



### **Rules and Regulations for B.T. Brown Reservoir**

1. B.T. Brown Reservoir will be open for public use Monday – Sunday from 8:00 a.m. until legal sundown or posted time.
2. Electric motors only – no gasoline motors or fuel tanks. No rubber or vinyl rafts permitted.
3. The lake is limited to 20 boats at a time.
4. All batteries must be strapped or bolted to boats.
5. No swimming or wading
6. No alcoholic beverages.
7. All carp fish must be released immediately.
8. No loitering or littering.
9. No firearms or air (or spring loaded) rifles/pistols.
10. Cooking allowed only on grills at the pavilion.
11. No pets or horses.
12. Minors must be accompanied by an adult.
13. No one under 16 years old may operate a water craft which is either electrically or manually operated.
14. All Georgia Fishing and Boating Laws apply. All Largemouth Bass 14” & under shall be released.
15. Restricted Areas: No one except authorized Coweta Water Authority Employees will be allowed in the following areas:
  - 1) The Dam area including, the spillway.
  - 2) The valve structure and associated cat walk.
  - 3) The outfall structure and the area below the dam structure.
16. Enforcement: All rules and regulations will be enforced by Coweta County Enforcement personnel and the Georgia DNR. Any violation of these rules will be considered a misdemeanor punishable under the laws of the State of Georgia.
